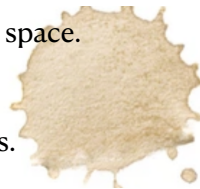

Isaiah's influence touched many ... in the streets, in the synagogue and yes, even in local hangouts such as coffeehouses ... predicting that God's people would undergo many hardships. But he is also known for his words of promise and encouragement. Come and experience the re-telling of Isaiah's beautiful messages that continue to fill listeners with hope, good news and rejoicing.
